Success isn't one-size-fits-all. Each participant's journey and achievements look a little different. Employment is always our ultimate goal, and each individual will have different needs and take a different path to get to their goal.

- 42% of our successful graduates received our assistance in assessing and addressing their disability-related or personal needs
- 14% of our successful graduates were referred to additional services, or had an individual plan developed

How We Do It



Digital Career Compass

A 20-hour structured vocational assessment that evaluates participants' professional, technical, computer, and work readiness skills.



Computer Essentials

A great introductory class for those with beginner-level computer skills or those who have extremely out-of-date computer experience.



Computer Skills Bootcamp

Students develop computer skills, better understand their strengths and weaknesses, refine their career goals, and identify steps to achieve them.



Computer Technician Training

Hands-on training in virtualization, networking, coding, and robotics, while covering key topics from the A+ certification exam.



PRO Customer Service and Administrative Training

A fun real-world curriculum. CTP's three mock businesses let students role-play real jobs, practicing phone skills, clerical work, and counter service.



Work Experience

Participants have the opportunity to practice their skills in real-world settings through a CTP internship.



Supported Job Search & Career Development Support

CTP participants get weekly support to help them search for jobs, prepare for interviews and stay successful once they're hired.

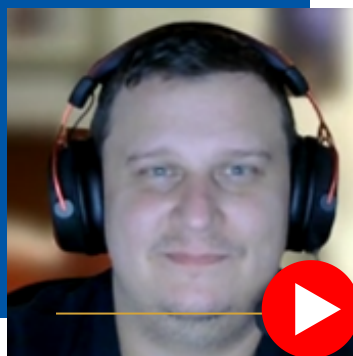
